## Course Description

Students will explore a variety of styles of music including but not limited to traditional, world, popular, jazz, musical theater, american spirituals, and american folk music while learning correct vocal technique, music literacy skills, and performance skills. Students will also learn how to work together as a team, what it means to be a part of a group, and the importance of working together towards a common goal.

## Educational Philosophy

## Concert Philosophy

Concerts and performances are a critical part of the learning experience in a performance based class. I encourage all parents and students to view concerts as a required part of the choral experience at Lineville. Concerts are an opportunity for your student to 'show off' and celebrate everything they have learned. Concerts also give parents, family, and the community a chance to see what amazing things today's youth are capable of.

From an educational perspective concerts also serve as a learning opportunity for students. It is their chance to apply everything that they have learned over the course of the quarter or semester. It is also the only opportunity they have to practice their performance skills. Concerts will serve as a formal assessment of performance skills. This experience is very difficult to replicate outside of a concert experience. Students who miss a concert, regardless of the reason for the absence, will be expected to complete a make-up activity. Students will be given all the time they need during class to complete the activity.

## Concert Expectations

- Students are encouraged to attend concerts
- If a child is unable to attend a concert it is the parents responsibility to contact me via email, phone, or note.
- Students will wear their Lineville Choir T-shirts to concerts. Students may wear what they want with the choir shirts. I ask that you please avoid athletic pants, athletic shorts, joggers, athletic leggings, sweatpants, etc. Jeans, tennies, khaki shorts, cargo shorts, jean shorts, dress shorts, nice leggings, skirts, and dress pants are all great choices to wear to concerts.

## Concert Dates

Below are the concert dates for the 2022-2023 school year. Please put these dates on your calendar. Concert times are yet to be determined and will be communicated as we get closer to the concerts. Concerts usually last approximately 20 minutes unless otherwise noted. Please note concerts are subject to change due to Covid-19 protocols. ## Choir T-shirts

Each child is expected to purchase a choir t-shirt as it is our uniform for concerts. T-shirts will be available for order on the LIneville website. Children do not need to order a t-shirt if they already have a choir shirt from a sibling. We will be using the same design as previous years, however, this year I will be switching to a dry fit shirt. If you prefer to continue to wear your shirt from last year that is ok or you can choose to order the new style.

If you need financial assistance with purchasing a t-shirt please contact me. I can assist with helping to secure a t-shirt for your child. **All orders must be placed by September 9.** Shirts cost \$10.00 (\$12.00 for adult XXL).

**IMPORTANT REMINDER** - these shirts are custom made. I will not place an order for the shirts until each family has placed their order. The shirts will be arriving in the middle of October. Once the shirts are in I will hand them out to the students during class. I will also send an email home letting you know to watch for the shirts.
